One of our greatest needs right now as the number of cell groups grows, is for new apprentice leaders to serve alongside the new cell group leaders. This calls for wisdom and discernment and we ask you to join us in praying for the Lord of the harvest to raise up workers for that harvest.

**We also ask for your prayers for many of the people we serve. In the last weeks, we have been involved in an intervention– part of which was caring for a child whose parent was involved in substance abuse. Another one of our folks is dealing with difficult custody issues with his son and seeking out God’s wisdom and help in it all. A third couple in our church just had a baby and is working through the issues of bringing him into a blended family. We are thankful for the opportunities to join God in his love and pursuit of precious lost people and appreciate your support.**
