INTERCESSOR'S JOURNAL

Thank you for your great support in prayer! We are excited to share with you many answers to prayer from the last two months. You may recall that we asked you to pray for a new season of emphasizing discipleship and evangelism through our triads that was to start February 1. Triads are small discipleship groups where people can be introduced to Jesus, discipled in Christ, and have first leadership experiences. When we began this new season there were many people in our church who had only experienced cell life. However, they had never taken the steps of learning to feed themselves God's Word, sharing their faith with others, or allowing God to share their character through the accountability of another follower of Christ in a triad.

We are thankful to God for his work in the lives of many. Since February 1, we have seen the number of triad groups more than double. Seven new triads were added in the month of February alone. We also added a new role in On The House Church. Each triad has a designated Triad Liaison who has contact with Jeff each week and serves as the link to On The House Church. Furthermore, the triad liaison is also responsible for communicating prayer requests and to the church. We started out with 0 liaisons, and God has raised up 12 new liaisons- and all this since February 1. We had hoped and prayed that this group of liaisons would

form a peer learning group as well where challenges and insights could be shared weekly with the other so that learning and growing could be shared among all those serving in this way. The response was very positive. Our liaison leaders have turned to one another for support, questions, and prayer needs in a way that has further strengthened the body life of On The House Church.

We ask that you continue to pray that these new groups can form, grow, and multiply so that new people can be introduced to life in Christ and new apprentice leaders for cell groups can be raised up. This is a key prayer request for the future fruitfulness of our church!

We wanted to celebrate with you how great it was to see our youngest daughter Gabrielle, make her profession of faith. She approached us a few months ago on this, and Michelle and I prepared her for this using an excellent booklet called "Children's Profession of Faith" put out by CRC Publications. Gabby made her profession of faith on February 27. She included a personal testimony as well as the words of Rich Mullins song "Step By Step". She closed by sharing her favorite passage Psalm 62:1,2 and explaining why that meant so much to her. She made it clear that faith in Jesus Christ was not just her parent's faith, but was her very own.

What was also very exciting is that a young adult from our church heard this and was so moved by her testimony that he has been led to make a profession of faith next Sunday! We pray that God will continue to transform the lives of people as we share together what God is doing in our lives. We continue to believe in the power of Jesus Christ to do an amazing work in the lives people.
