## **EXPLORING THE LIFE OF MOSES**

### ***What One Lesson Did You Focus On This Week?***

This past Sunday, Pastor Sam Hamstra preached on "Thank the Lord for Women" (re-named "Girls Rock," thanks to Karissa Cano); we examined a handful of faithful women who stood up to the king before and after the birth of Moses. Behind the scenes we saw God working and learned three lessons: 1) just as Moses' parents demonstrated remarkable faith by trusting in God and finding out that he is trustworthy so, too, we can trust and count on him to meet us where we are; 2) God sees our needs and provides; and, 3) God is faithful to his promises.
