Dear Brethren,

Please help us praying for the challenges we're facing as individuals and as a ministry. As we plan to develop new outreach community programs, finances are tight and resources are low. We're projecting a deficit of more than ten thousand dollars by the end of the current year (December 31, 2011). We need to raise at least fifty thousand dollars to consider launching the two programs that we have in mind. One of the programs is oriented to help the documented immigrants, of any ethnicity, to learn the American system and settle down in this area. We'll be providing guidance as to how to start a new business, English classes, computer training, development of job skills, job placement, preparation of resume, and application to local, state and federal aid among other things.

The second program is the beginning of a Voluntary Pre-Kinder (VPK) for 3-4 years old children. This is a project that would give the ministry a great exposure as we make ourselves available to the community providing them an educational service.

We continue ministering the Latino population in Lake Worth/West Palm Beach with success to some extent. We're growing slowly, adding a family here and there but nothing significantly. We still need more young families with children and pre-teens.

The congregation is being faithful and spiritually healthy. We all feel encouraged to give the best that we have in order to make this ministry a success story.
