Best efforts have been made in regards to community health services. There are no serious diseases and illnesses in these past days. Two houses (one person is a believer) made their own proper toilet from our health campaign. Many patients came to our clinic suffering from common colds and fevers.

I would like to give a brief report of a man who lived in the city. He is been suffering from a kidney problems. He lived in the city, about 80 km from my posting place. One day some people called me to pray for him. He was very weak and depressed; the doctor said that he needed operation from the ultrasound result. There is some Hindu idols and sacred in their living room. I requested that they removed all of their Hindu idols. After that I read the Nepali Bible and prayed for him; he got a little improved within an hour. I have no the exact medicine for his diseases, so I gave a simple medicines and we prayed again and again. The last time we prayed he had improved significantly. He want to the Hospital for a check up again and was admitted, but they discharged at the next day because they did not find any serious problems. God answered our humble prayers and worked through the simple medicines which we gave him. All of his family member saw the love God and they want to be baptized. All of them attend church often and have accepted Jesus Christ. I thank God for the great thing he has done.

At present two new people are prepared to be baptized in our church.

Lastly, I request you offer prayer continuously for my services here in Nepal. I will also continue to pray for you.
