

CHRISTIAN REFORMED WORLD MISSIONS 2010 POSTER CONTEST RULES

1. Children and young people up to and including grade 8 are eligible to enter.
2. Materials: paper, pencil, pencil crayons, markers, paint, crayons, ink and glue.
3. Poster Size: minimum 8 ½ x 11, maximum 11 x 17.
4. Entry Form: one filled in entry form must be taped to the back of each poster.
5. Themes are as follows:
 - Reaching the World with the Power of the Gospel
 - Witnesses to the Light
 - Across the Street and Around the World
 - Missions Means Me
 - Praying for the Harvest
6. Postmarked by: **April 16, 2010**

7. Judging: Judging will take place approximately two weeks after the closing date. Volunteers will judge the posters according to mission theme, artistic expression and originality.
8. Ownership: Posters will become the property of CRWM Canada. Suitable winning posters may be chosen for use in World Missions promotional material such as bulletin covers.
9. Categories: Posters will be judged for placement of 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Honourable Mention in four age groups: Ages: 6 and under; Ages 7– 8, Ages 9-10, Ages 11 and above.

School Award: The school that submits the most entries will receive a certificate of recognition.
10. Prizes: Certificates will be awarded to the winning entrants. Each local church or school whose student submitted a winning entry will be given a certificate to present to the winning artist. All entrants will receive a memento as a thank-you gift from CRWM.
