

HOW CAN I SERVE YOU?

A. SERVICE

I want to be of service to the Missions Advocates in each of the churches in my region, to the leaders and congregations of each of these churches, and to the missionaries sent out through World Missions by these churches. In an effort to accomplish this, some of the ways I can serve you include the following.

1. **Scheduling Missionaries** – If you need a missionary speaker for any occasion, I can schedule someone for you or give you the names and telephone numbers of missionaries on home service so that you can contact them directly. We encourage churches to involve missionaries in both formal and informal settings.
2. **Newsletter** – I send each Missions Advocate a monthly newsletter with prayer updates, reports from the fields, and interesting facts about missions. The newsletter or a portion of it can be duplicated and put in bulletins or church newsletters.
3. **Prayer items** – From time to time I will share special concerns and items of praise with you to pass on to your congregation for those missionaries your church supports. You can sign up to receive ePray – a weekly prayer update on the ministries of CRWM. You can call the CRC Prayer Line and listen to a recording of prayer needs for the agencies of the CRC.  - d. Sunday/Church School – Conduct a 30-45 minute missions-focused event for elementary grades to high school.
