Fun facts about our 2007 teams:

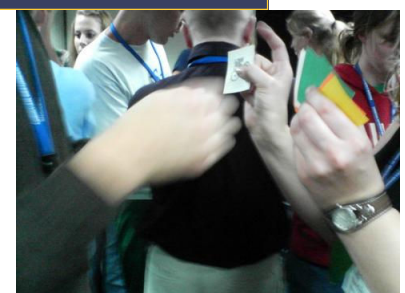
- 8 SMPers
