Calf Bangladesh

Calves provide milk that can be consumed by the family, but it can also be sold as a source of income.



Goat International

A goat means a big step toward financial security, through providing milk and offspring that can be sold or given away.



Rabbit Guatemala, Kenya

Children can help care for rabbits, which reproduce quickly and can then be sold for meat in the market.



Nutrition Kit Honduras

Providing a nutrition kit, including soybean (for nutritious milk), vitamins, and medicine, can reverse the course of child nutritional defects.



Chicken Bangladesh

The gift of a chicken is a wonderful source of nutrition, in their eggs and their meat.



Sheep Guatemala

In Guatemala, a sheep can change life on the farm—they provide wool, meat, and manure to help with farming.



Pig India, Guatemala

Pigs can be reared and fed at home, then sold at market for food.

Clean Water Fund International

This gift provides resources toward our ongoing efforts to provide clean water to some of the one billion people around the world who need it.

Water Filter Cambodia, Honduras

The gift of a water filter can mean the difference between consistent health and perpetual sickness.

Water Storage Container Honduras

This gift allows people to collect and store water, something difficult to do in Honduras.

Water for Disaster Survivors International

This gift will help provide one of the basic elements of life necessary to rebuild homes, villages, and communities after a disaster.



Youth Advocate Training Senegal

Youth advocate training allows young people to go to school, gain marketable skills, and live healthier lives so that they can positively impact their culture.

Mosquito Nets International

Sleeping under a mosquito net every night greatly reduces the risk of becoming infected with malaria or dengue fever.



School Fees Nigeria

This gift provides books, pens and pencils, school uniforms, shoes, and a book bag for an orphan in Nigeria.



Latrine Cambodia, Mozambique

A latrine means greatly reduced illness and increased dignity for the people in a village.



Baby Weighing Scale Bangladesh

A baby-weighing scale, gives health workers a simple way to both quantify a child's growth and discuss a plan for better child nutrition with the mother.

Microloan Haiti, Nigeria

A microloan gives a woman the opportunity to start her own business, transforming overall family health and education.



Heap of Yam Seedlings Nigeria

A heap of yam seedlings will allow a woman to start her own farm, empowering her to support her immediate and extended family in an area with vast, rich farmland.



3 Literacy Books Western Africa, Zambia

These literacy textbooks teach adults how to read and write in their own language.

Business Management Training Western Africa

A gift of business training will help a woman feed her children, cover medical expenses, pay school fees, and handle general living expenses.



Lantern India, Bangladesh

A gift of a lantern will allow men to learn at night after working to feed their families during the day.



Literacy Book Set Bangladesh, Honduras

The gift of a book set is shared by a community, functioning as a library where participants can check out and return books.

School Desk Honduras

These desks can be used by three students at once, dramatically improving their learning experience.





Where Needed Most
CRWRC partners with over 85 churches and organizations to work in over 25 countries around the world, meeting practical needs in the name of Jesus. Your gift enables us to respond to the areas of greatest need.



Fruit Tree Cambodia
A gift of a fruit tree provides for both an immediate need (food) and a long-term benefit (environmental stewardship.)



Trafficking Prevention Bangladesh, Nicaragua
A gift in this area will fund CRWRC efforts in Bangladesh and Nicaragua to educate community, church, and government leaders in how to prevent trafficking and protect women, children, and adolescents from this horrible practice.

HIV/AIDS Stepping Stones Training Malawi
The Stepping Stones training program, an intensive and highly participatory 5-10 day program, will give a community the tools it needs to understand the HIV and AIDS risks it faces.



Blanket or Sleeping Mat
In a disaster, a simple blanket or sleeping mat can provide warmth or a place to sleep.

Small Hand Tools North America
A gift of small tools provides the hammers, nail guns, and paint brushes needed for CRWRC volunteers to repair and rebuild homes damaged by hurricanes, floods, and tornados.

1. identify key challenges holding families back from escaping poverty, and
2. develop and implement programs to address these issues.
