Getting Started

Since these pages are hosted within Google Sites, you need a Google Account to access it. You don't need to use Gmail, their email service. All you need is a Google Account. Google Accounts are free and give us a secure method of granting restricted access to Interchange. Best of all, with a Google Account you can use your existing email address and password...no need to **remember a new username or password!**

Here's how to get started...

Step 1 - Get Invited

Did you receive our email (or memo) inviting you to this page? If so, it means you're already "on the list" and, as soon as you log in, you'll have full access to Interchange (so you can download documents, add comments, subscribe to email alerts, and more).

Step 2 - Get a Google Account (if you don't have one)

- *If you don't have a Google Account.....you'll need to get one first. Click here: <https://www.google.com/accounts/ManageAccount> Be sure to use the same email as we have on file for you (or give us a new one to add).*
- *If you already have a Gmail or Google Account...just make sure your email invitation was sent to the email address that's associated with your Gmail/Google Account. If it was, you can skip this step. If it was not, please give us that email address so we can add it to the permissions list.*

Step 3 - Sign In

If you aren't already logged in to your Google Account, you'll see the CRCNA staff login page:
