Children can help care for rabbits, which reproduce quickly and can then be sold for meat in the market.

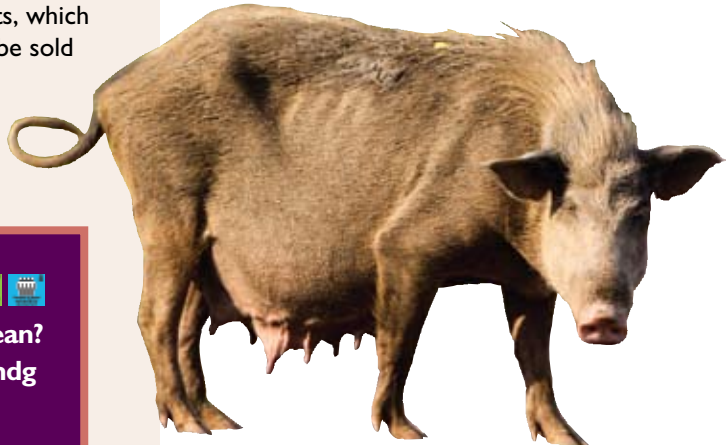

Changed Lives . . . As Seen in Onions

"I used to buy seeds two or three times each gardening season," said Ona.* "I didn't know much about gardening, so many plants would die."

But this year was different. CRWRC organized a gardening training session, funded by the Foods Resource Bank, in a nearby village to improve food security in the area. Ona's village sent a representative that learned how to prepare planting beds, how far apart to plant the seeds, and how to water and protect the plants.

The village representative came back and taught her community members what she had learned. Ona put everything she learned into practice immediately. Instead of just planting lettuce and cabbage, she and several others thought, "Let's try planting onions." Red onions are known to be a valuable export crop throughout Western Africa because they are likely to yield higher profits than lettuce and cabbage.

The results were spectacular. Whereas in the previous year Ona earned only about \$25 in profit during the whole season, this year Ona has already sold \$60 worth of produce. In addition, she has stored six sacks of onions, each worth \$40-\$50, that she hopes to sell in the off-season when prices are much higher.

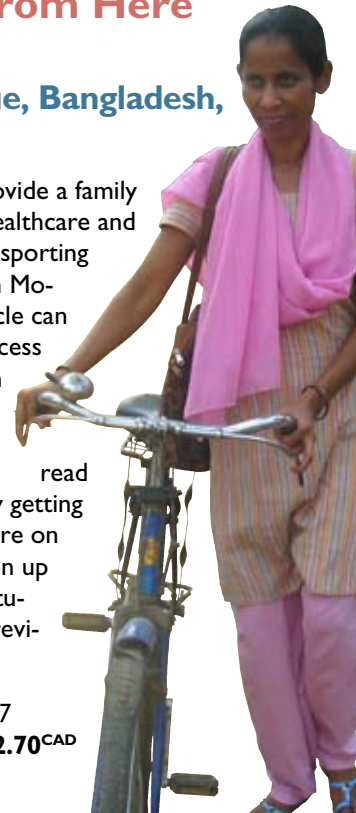
