

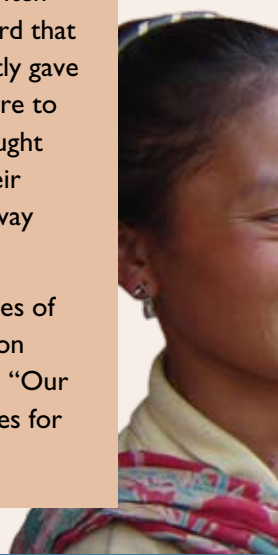

Djibo participated in a health training in his home village in Western Africa. “I learned that mosquitoes, which are out most often at night, cause malaria. I had never heard that before!” When the government recently gave out free mosquito nets, Djibo made sure to get some for his family. They even bought additional ones so that everyone in their compound now sleeps safely tucked away from the mosquitoes.

Djibo also learned about different causes of diarrhea, and has shared this information with his village as well as those nearby. “Our community group wants to build latrines for our village,” Djibo explained.

“I was truly amazed at the generosity of our guests,” Goud said. “Many paid double for their meals. . . . It is absolutely amazing what a few people can do with a little help from our friends. We did nine meals and fed 80 people, but we will have helped more than 90 families in ways that we in our culture cannot fathom. I hope this story will inspire others . . . because then we will have helped thousands.”

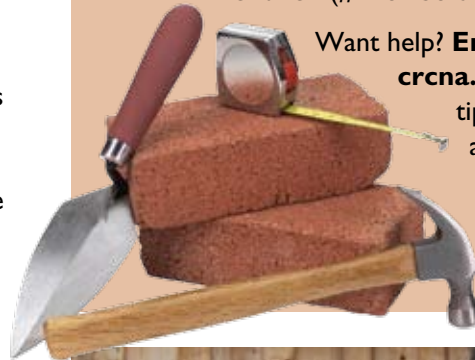
