I come before your throne with reverence, remembering Paul's words to the Ephesians. Like him, I ask for divine empowerment for all who proclaim your truth today. As Paul requested prayer "that words may be given to me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel," I lift up the messengers of your Word.

Lord, place your words in their mouths. When they stand to speak, may they not rely on human wisdom but on the power of your Spirit. Grant them supernatural boldness—not a brash or arrogant spirit but holy courage that can come only from you. Help them to speak clearly, compassionately, and without compromise.

Paul described himself as an "ambassador in chains." Many of your servants today face their own chains—whether literal imprisonment in hostile nations or the chains of social pressure, fear, or inadequacy. Remind them that they represent the King of kings and that their authority comes not from their position but from the message they carry.

Like Paul, help them to speak boldly and fearlessly, "as [they] should." Not with timidity or apology but with the firm conviction that the gospel is still "the power of God that brings salvation" (Rom. 1:16).

Finally, I pray for those who hear. Open hearts to receive this mystery that was hidden for ages but is now revealed in Christ Jesus.

Clothed with Power

Introduction

Jesus opened the minds of his followers gathered in the room so that they could understand the Scriptures. In a new way they recognized that God has been at work since the beginning of history (his story). But the story isn't done. Repentance for the forgiveness of sins is to be preached. And Jesus promises to the disciples gathered in that room that they will go out, not in their own power, but "clothed with power from on high" (Luke 24:49).

We go out into the world, as individuals, as churches, and as a denomination, "clothed with power from on high." The Holy Spirit's indwelling gives us what we need for the work we are called to do. Ministry, working in our communities, transforming lives, preaching repentance for the forgiveness of sins, cannot be done in our own strength, with our own plans, or by our own agendas, but only through the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, who is at work within and through us.

Suggested Bible Reading:

(Indonesian) Luke 24:37-39

Tetapi kamu harus tinggal di dalam kota ini sampai kamu diperlengkapi dengan kekuasaan dari tempat tinggi."

Luke 24:37-49

They were startled and frightened, thinking they saw a ghost. He said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts rise in your minds? Look at my hands and my feet. It is I myself! Touch me and see; a ghost does not have flesh and bones, as you see I have."

When he had said this, he showed them his hands and feet. And while they still did not believe it because of joy and amazement, he asked them, "Do you have anything here to eat?" They gave him a piece of broiled fish, and he took it and ate it in their presence.

He said to them, "This is what I told you while I was still with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms."

Then he opened their minds so they could understand the Scriptures. He told them, "This is what is written: The Messiah will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, and repentance for the forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high."




Guide especially our delegates and our leaders. May they serve as one body of believers fully committed to the tasks before them. Help us all, always, to remember who it is that we serve.
