IX. Response to Overture 10: Reaffirm Authority of Local Consistory in Baptism

A. Materials

Overture 10, pp. 357-362

B. Recommendations:

- 1. That synod affirm that the authority for granting baptism is held with the local consistory in accordance with Church Order Article 55 and synodical decisions.
- 2. That synod remind churches that baptismal rites are not to be used to affirm that same sex marriage is ecclesiastically valid.

Grounds:

- a. The local consistory, adhering to the creeds and confessions, is best able to discern and make a decision regarding all the facts (including their faith) surrounding a request by any parent(s) to have their child baptized.
- b. Article 56 of the Church Order provides that the primary criterion for baptism of a child is that the "the covenant of God shall be sealed to children of confessing members" who are not under discipline (C.O. Supplement, Articles 78-81, b).
- 3. That synod declare this to be its response to Overture 10.
