SPOTLIGHT ENGLISH CLUBS provide a way for individuals and churches to meet in their community and around the world. The clubs (both Local Clubs and Skype Clubs) provide a place for English learners to gather in groups to practice conversation skills and build relationships. Many new immigrants are looking to learn English in a way that connects them to people who care. Additionally, people living in other countries are also looking to learn English - particularly in settings that might be “creative access”.

LOCAL CLUBS meet either at a church or a neutral location. The main point is that English learners come to practice speaking English with people who are Christians and who care about them. Spotlight English Clubs give you the materials to keep your club interesting, and take away the burden of finding resources.

SKYPE CLUBS allow you to connect with English learners around the world from your home. With Skype and Spotlight English Club materials, you can develop friendships with people who are hungry to learn English using Spotlight’s conversations starters.

How much time do I need to invest?

Local Club: You will listen to the 15-minute program together as a group, discuss and then hang out for some socializing. The entire meeting should take 1.5-2 hours.

Skype Club: You will email the program to your English learners and they will listen to it before the club meeting. Then at the time of your club you will meet with them for 1-1.5 hours per week to discuss the program using Spotlight’s conversation starters.

How is this a ministry?

In addition to servicing a practical need (learning English), you are building relationships. All the programs are written from a Christian world view, and there are opportunities to have spiritual conversations as you develop relationships. For Skype, it gives opportunities to speak with people in countries where it is difficult to have a physical presence as a Christian.
