Advocacy message (back side):

Dear Minister Philpott & PM Trudeau:

Because residential schools did so much damage in Indigenous communities, I'm asking you to work towards justice and equity in education.

Some good steps have already been taken, but the grade 12 graduation rate for Indigenous students is still 24%, compared to the national average of 90%.

This must change, and it can change. Great examples like Mi'kmaw Kina'matnewey show that equitable funding, strong language and culture curriculum, and the participation of communities and Elders make a massive difference for Indigenous kids.

I'm asking you to fully implement TRC Calls to Action 7-10.

Together, we can close the education gap!
